TECHNICAL REGULATION CONCERNING STATE OF EMERGENCY OVER THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) OUTBREAK FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS AT TELKOM UNIVERSITY

Considering the increasing number of COVID-19 cases in Indonesia, including in West Java, and referring to the Rector's Circular Letter Number: 045/SKR4/REK/2020 dated March 23rd, 2020, Telkom University has adopted a decision as follows:

- 1. Learning activities will be carried out online until the End of Even Semester 2019/2020 Academic Year.
- 2. Students are encouraged to return to their respective countries.
- 3. Students who return to home country must report to the International Office not later than March 27th, 2020. The recommended return schedules are as follows:
 - a. Thursday, March 26th, 2020
 - b. Tuesday, March 31st, 2020
 - c. Monday, April 5th, 2020
- 4. Students should carry out a medical check before returning to home country and submit a health certificate to the International Office.
- 5. Students' return to home country will be carried out in group dan departures to the airport will be coordinated by the International Office.
- 6. Students who decide to stay should fill out a statement letter.
- 7. Students who stay at campus must follow the regulation issued by the campus during the COVID-19 pandemic state.

This regulation is effective immediately (as of March 23th, 2020). Telkom University can develop any other further principles to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, as appropriate, and will inform the students via subsequent updates.
